

It's a name I will carry with pride, even long after I leave these walls.





# Recent Update on Planet Research

## Wide-Orbit Planets:

Researchers have made progress in understanding how wide-orbit planets form. These planets, like the hypothetical Planet Nine in our solar system, are thought to be created when gravitational kicks from nearby stars stabilize their orbits. Scientists expect to find roughly one wide-orbit planet for every thousand stars.



## Super-Earths:

NASA's research has uncovered a diverse range of super-Earths, which are planets larger than Earth but smaller than Neptune. These planets can be rocky, watery, or gaseous and offer insights into planetary evolution. Some super-Earths, like Kepler-452 b, orbit stars similar to the Sun and might be habitable.



## New Planetary System:

Astronomers discovered a unique planetary system, TOI-2096, consisting of a super-Earth and a mini-Neptune orbiting a cold star. This system could be key to understanding planetary formation and the anomaly known as the "Radius Valley."



## Exoplanet Discoveries:

NASA has confirmed over 5,000 exoplanets, with many more candidates waiting to be studied. Researchers are excited about upcoming space missions like PLATO and JWST, which will help probe exoplanet atmospheres and potentially reveal signs of life.

### GRAVITY FORCE




**Gravity:** Objects fall towards the ground due to gravity.




**Electricity:** A form of energy that powers devices and machines.




**DNA:** Genetic material that determines our traits and characteristics.
